•Consider buying groceries: for those who may not have money or the ability to shop outside the home

•Help with Daily Tasks: Do they need help getting their trash can emptied? How about yard work? Do they need a prescription picked up?

- •Communication: Share cards, calls, notes, and text messages regularly
