LIVE ALIVE, pt 1 - LIVE FREE
Galatians 5:1-23

1) FREE in GRACE (Gal 5:1-6)

"What ultimately counts in this life is what ultimately matters on the day of judgment. And what will make a difference on the day of judgment? The very same thing that makes all the difference on the day we're justified—namely, faith. It's critical for all of us believer's to live with ETERNITY always in mind."

2) FREE to LOVE (Gal 5:13-14)

3) FREE to WALK in the SPIRIT (Gal 5:15-23)
