

Why should we consider or experience the season of Lent? Lent is not a biblical mandate but it is a practice that Christians have participated in dating back to the very early church. It is a 6-week season before Holy Week and Easter where, because of Christ's suffering for our sin, we choose to deny our flesh, serve others, and humbly prepare for the Greatest Day in History – RESURRECTION SUNDAY!

How do I get the most from the Lent Season?

- Here are some of my practices and suggestions:
- 1. Make extra time to study the Gospels and spend time praying.
- 2. Find a way, place, or ministry to SERVE beyond my normal practices.
- 3. "Fast" (deny myself) something that I enjoy and replace it with prayer. - Each time I think of this thing, pray and thank Jesus for His sacrifice

    Use the time to read scripture, pray, or serve.
- 4. Focus on Jesus' painful suffering and sacrificial death, that was a result of my sin. Allow the Holy Spirit to examine my heart deeper than ever.

How can this help me in my relationship with God?

This experience has helped me realize on a very small scale what Jesus went through because of my sin. It gives me a deeper love and appreciation for all that God has done for me IN CHRIST and my salvation. Finally, it helps me to experience greater JOY and CELEBRATION on Resurrection Sunday.


