## Think on These Things

Prayer, in one form or another, is mentioned over 600 times in the Bible (the actual number of times varies, by translation). I don't know about you, but I think this is a pretty clear indication that praying is something that God wants us to do. Sometimes, I will hear someone say that they don't have time to pray. My response to that is usually something like, "Friend, you don't have time not to pray!" It is noted of the Reformer, Martin Luther, that when asked about why he prayed so much, he replied, "Because I have so much to do." (According to historians, Martin Luther was an extremely busy man.) We may not be able to devote an hour or two (at one time) to daily prayer like Luther did, but we should always take time to pray as we have the opportunity. I Thessalonians 5:17 tells us to "Pray without ceasing". This means that we should constantly be ready to pray (have an attitude of prayer), because our underlying thoughts are continually being brought back to God. We should not have to work ourselves up to pray; it should be as much a part of our daily lives as breathing. So the next time you are tempted to think that you don't have time to pray, ask yourself, "Would I ever say that I don't have time to breathe?" Just something to think about as we go about our week.

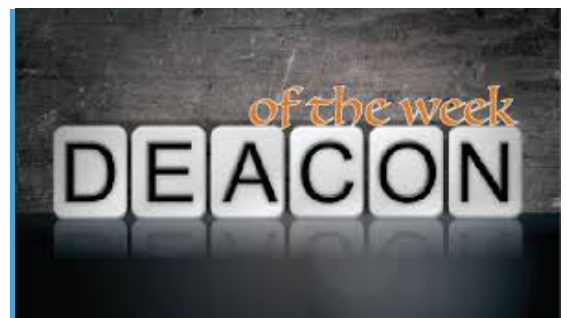
