

Think on These Things

Jesus, when speaking to the Samaritan woman at the well, said to her, "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him." (John 4:23 NKJV)

Worship is something that is vital to the life of a follower of Christ, yet it is also something that is woefully neglected, largely because worship is so misunderstood. When you talk about worship, often the first thing that comes to mind is music and singing, yet worship is so much more than those things.

As one has put it: "Worship is the nourishment of the mind upon God's truth. Worship is the quickening of the conscience by God's holiness. Worship is the cleansing of the imagination by God's beauty. Worship is the response of my life to God's plan for my life."

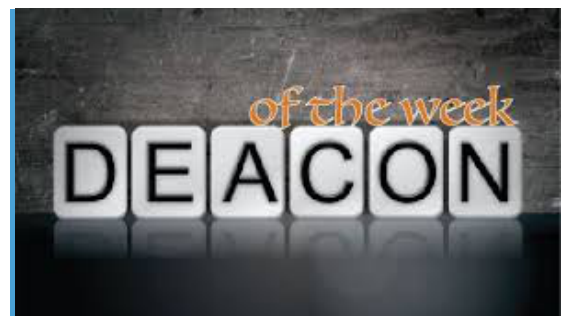
