# Think on These Things

I want to share a brief story with you today. I hope it makes you think as it has made me think. Here it is: John Wesley (the founder of Methodism) came down for breakfast in a melancholy mood. He was miserable. Sensing the situation, Mrs. Wesley went upstairs, dressed in black, and came down to join him. "Who is dead?" Wesley asked. "God," she replied. "Oh, no!" he said. Mrs. Wesley responded, "Well, I thought He must be, from your countenance and conduct."

"What do people see when they look at my face?" is the question we need to ask ourselves and honestly answer. Do they see joy or distress? Happiness or hostility? Love or loathing? Peace or pain? Genuine interest or apathy? I know that we all have days when we're "out of sorts", but what do people see the majority of the time?
