## Think on These Things

I want to share a brief story with you today. I hope it makes you think as it has made me think. Here it is: John Wesley (the founder of Methodism) came down for breakfast in a melancholy mood. He was miserable.

Sensing the situation, Mrs. Wesley went upstairs, dressed in black, and came down to join him. "Who is dead?" Wesley asked. "God," she replied. "Oh, no!" he said. Mrs. Wesley responded, "Well, I thought He must be, from your countenance and conduct."

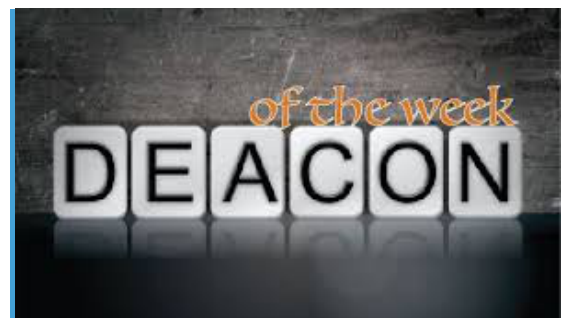
