Whenever AI would opine about things going on in the world, it would often be from a standpoint that differed from Scripture, so I would usually say," I can understand how you might think or feel that way, but the Bible says..." We all have ALs in our lives that shape how we view the world.

Here are a few: SociAL, PoliticAL, FinanciAL, PersonAL, PhysicAL, EducationAL, PrejudiciAL, RaciAL, and EmotionAL are just some of the ALs that we are familiar with. When speaking of things going on in the world, one or more of these ALs usually come into play and influence our perceptions and opinions, for better or worse.
