Whenever AI would opine about things going on in the world, it would often be from a standpoint that differed from Scripture, so I would usually say, "I can understand how you might think or feel that way, but the Bible says..." AI would then explain what the "experts" said; I would say what the Bible says, and so on. Usually there was an agreement to politely disagree. We all have AIs in our lives that shape how we view the world.

Here are a few: SociAL, PoliticAL, FinanciAL, PersonAL, PhysicAL, EducationAL, PrejudiciAL, RaciAL, and EmotionAL are just some of the AIs that we are familiar with. When speaking of things going on in the world, one or more of these AIs usually come into play and influence our perceptions and opinions, for better or worse. The most important AI concerning our worldview should be BiblicAL. 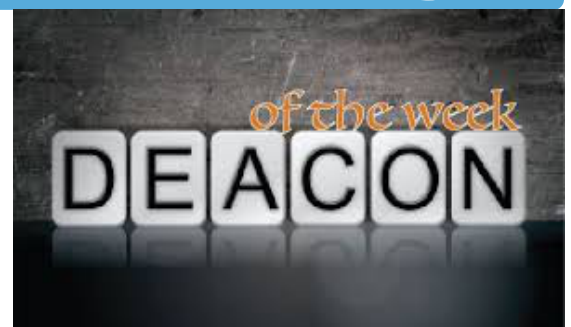
