Think On These Things

What sets Christianity apart from all other religions? The founders of every other religion are dead; only the Founder of Christianity, Jesus Christ, is alive. But don't just take my word for it; listen to what Paul had to say to the church at Corinth, bearing in mind that scholars have dated this letter to have been written between 53 and 56 A.D. or about 20-25 years after the events described here.

"Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. 6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. 7 After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. 8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time." I Corinthians 15:1-8 NKJV

What Paul is testifying to here is that Jesus was crucified, was dead, was buried, and was raised from the dead, but IS now alive! This is what sets Christianity apart! Jesus Christ IS ALIVE and He is still saving (delivering, rescuing) people from their sin today! Please do not go another moment without Him, if you have not yet trusted Him! If you do know Him, then please don't keep Him a secret; tell others! You, and they, will be glad that you did.

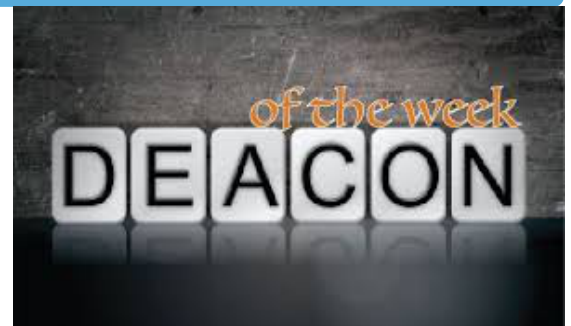
