## Think On These Things

A quote by Oswald Chambers is on my desk at home and greets me each morning:

"The impossible is exactly what God does." This serves as a daily reminder that no matter how hopeless a situation appears, how difficult, how seemingly insurmountable, how wearying or how "impossible" - "... with God nothing will be impossible." (Lk 1:37) Nothing happens in my life, or yours, that catches God by surprise. In fact, the trials He allows to come our way often serve as tests of our faith, to see whether we will trust Him to see us through or if we will rely upon our own strength or wisdom. No matter how many times we may fail these tests of faith, we have the assurance that God will never leave us nor forsake us (Heb 13:6). David reminds us that "As a father pities his children, so the LORD pities those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust." Psalm 103:13-14

I write all of this to remind you again that God knows who you are, what you are going through, that He cares for you more than anyone on this earth ever could, and that He wants you to trust Him to see you through. Jesus restored sight to the blind, made the lame (crippled) to walk, the deaf to hear, the mute to speak, cast out demons, raised the dead and gave Himself as the ultimate Sacrifice to atone for our sins. All of these things are "impossible", but He did these things and more! I ask God to remind you of these facts as you go through whatever you are going through right now. "The impossible is exactly what God does."
