This past week Ashley sent me the following which I would like to share with you:

"The most important ability in the work of the LORD is availability. The one with few gifts and little talent, who has a passion and a drive to see God's work done, will accomplish far more than a gifted and talented person who doesn't have the passion and drive to do the LORD's work."

"Viggo Olsen, who helped rebuild ten thousand houses in war-raved Bangladesh in 1972, derived unexpected inspiration from reading a chapter ordinarily considered one of the least interesting in the Bible (Nehemiah 3): 'I was struck... that no expert builders were listed in the "Holy Land brigade." There were priests, priests' helpers, goldsmiths, perfume makers, and women, but no expert builders or carpenters were named.'" (Yamauchi)

All too often we think that only the person who is most talented, most educated, most connected, most popular, most financially stable, most (fill-in-the-blank) is the one whom God will bless and make Most Successful. I have found, though, that the only "most" the Lord is looking for when it comes to His work is the one who is "Most Available". Jesus fed 5000 men plus women and children with the sack lunch of 5 loaves and 2 fish that a young boy freely offered. I have often wondered if there was anyone else there with a lunch that maybe they deemed insufficient to share and therefore either ate it themselves or just didn't offer it to any of the disciples. It doesn't really matter (since the boy shared his) except to think of the blessing that they missed out on by their reluctance to share.

I pray that we will present ourselves to God and be willing to freely share what He has given us in order to bring glory to His Name. Remember: He Himself is the one who rewards those who are Most Available.
