Think on These Things

"Discouragement is such a powerful weapon because it is somewhat the opposite of faith. Where faith believes God and His love and promises, discouragement looks for and believes the worst — and tends to pretty much forget about who God is and what He has promised to do."

When I read this quote, I was reminded of the story of when the Enemy was having a tool sale. He had all kinds of different tools with differing price tags on each. One tool, worn, with nothing shiny, flashy or glitzy about it was priced 100 times higher than all of the other tools. One asked the Enemy why that worn out tool commanded such a high price to which the Adversary replied, "That tool is called Discouragement and it is my most effective tool against those who would follow the Lord. You see, when I make a Christian become discouraged over circumstances and situations, they quit telling or showing others about the love of Christ. They often quit praying and the ones who do pray don't pray with any hope or expectation. If you want to win the battle over Christians, then you have to get them discouraged and keep them that way. I've been using this tool for a long time with great results!"

Maybe you've been discouraged lately over different things in your life. If so, remember that it is not the LORD who is bringing this discouragement, but the Enemy, the hater of the LORD and His people who is seeking to discourage you. My prayer is that you will not allow the Enemy to win, but that you will earnestly seek the LORD in prayer and will allow Him to speak peace, comfort, encouragement and healing to your heart and mind.

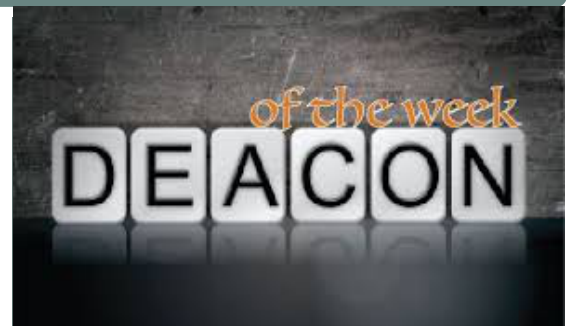
