world." (I John 4:4) God also tells us, in several places, that

the just or righteous walk by faith and not by sight. Therefore, we should not look at what we can see with our physical eyes (lest we may grow discouraged), but we should look at what can be (what God wants) through eyes of faith, trusting Him to accomplish His purposes through us here at FRBC. I hope that you will join me on this journey and that as we travel together we will grow more committed to God, His plans, and each other as His church. We can be an uncommon church by becoming biblical church members. May God help us to do so for His sake and for His glory!
