## Think on These Things

Have you ever felt discouraged? Have you ever felt like no one understands or cares? Have you ever just felt "out-of-sorts" for no identifiable reason? Well, I have and let me tell you, it's not enjoyable nor a state in which I care to stay! "Self-pity is of the devil" is a statement that I've read and heard many times and I would have to agree with the truthfulness of it. Why? Because when I get my eyes on myself, instead of keeping them on the LORD, I am in essence telling Him, "I can run my own life in this matter. I don't need Your help."; I am putting myself on His throne and telling Him to go away and leave me alone. What foolishness! "Surely you have things turned around! Shall the potter be esteemed as the clay; for shall the thing made say of him who made it, 'He did not make me'? Or shall the thing formed say of him who formed it, 'He has no understanding'?" (Is 29:16) "Woe to him who strives with his Maker! Let the potsherds strive with the potsherds of the earth! Shall the clay say to him who forms it, 'What are you making?' Or shall your handiwork say, 'He has no hands'?" (Is 45:9) Whenever I allow myself to wallow in the swamp of self-pity, I am basically questioning God, His wisdom, His love for me, and His will in my life. Again, what foolishness! What selfishness!

However, I want to give you a remedy for this malady of self-pity. Ready? Three times in Psalm 42 and 43, the psalmist says: "Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him for the help of His countenance." Or, as the NLT puts it: "Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise Him again- my Savior and my God!" What the Holy Spirit is telling us through the psalmist is this: When I am discouraged or sad, I need to praise the LORD, remembering who He is, what He has done, and that He is "...a very present help in time of trouble". (Ps 46:1b) When I get my eyes off of myself and back on God, then my outlook changes, regardless of whether or not the circumstances have changed. We all probably get down from time to time; the important thing is to put our eyes on the LORD and let Him lift us back up. This begins by hoping (trusting) in Him and lifting up our praises to Him.
