We have given out many Bibles in various languages to people who are so excited to have a real Bible in their own language. We don't often see the results of the seeds we are sowing, but we can trust that the Lord is working in many amazing ways! I pray that the Lord will put on your heart to pray for these students and families who are being brought to us to be ministered to every week. Reaching the nations for Christ takes time, effort, resources, prayer, and love for every person in every nation. We are so thankful for our ESL volunteers who are so faithful to come every week, and sacrifice many things in order to minister to our students. It is not always easy, but it is worth it! Ask the Lord how you can be involved through prayer, through interacting with students at ESL and other events, or even becoming an English teacher (it's easy if you speak English!). Don't miss this opportunity to minister to others. We can all do something. "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace." (1 Peter 4:10) And that's something to think about!
