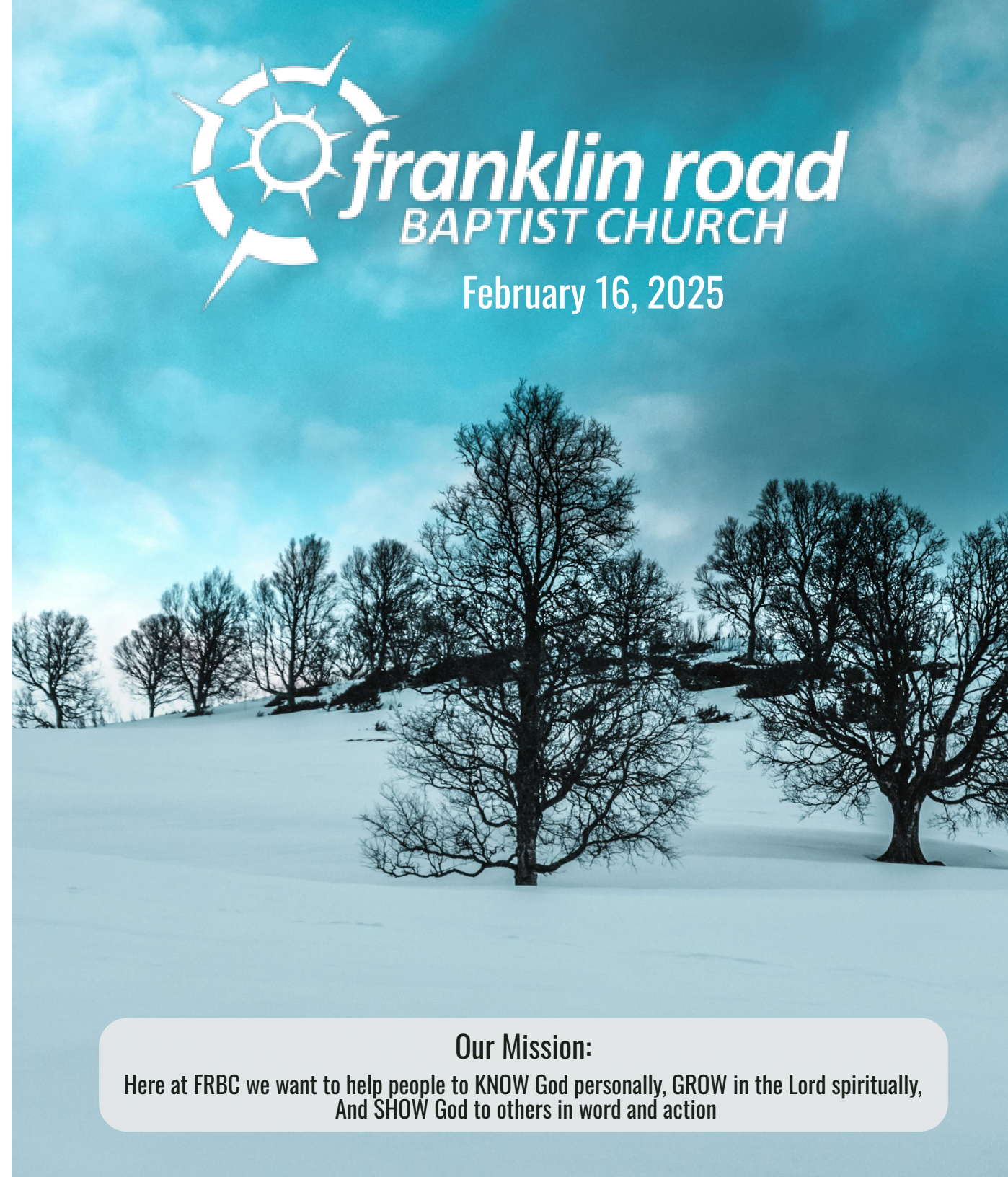

You've probably noticed in the bulletin that February has been designated as "I Love Rockridge" month. You've probably also noticed that the bulletin also says "More details coming soon." Well, today is "soon" and here are "more details".

Camp Rockridge was founded in 1957 by three Baptist Associations in west central Georgia. Representatives from Carrollton Baptist Association, Troup Baptist Association, and Western Baptist Association purchased the property with the goal of developing a camp where people could experience Jesus Christ. The camp is located off Highway 100 just north of Franklin GA.

It is situated on 168 acres of picturesque land with large rock formations and a beautiful lake. The camp has two cabins, a conference center, a pool, a pavilion, a chapel, a large cafeteria, and two smaller buildings with meeting rooms and lodging. In 2024 alone, the camp had some 3,480 visitors composed primarily of different children's' group camps and various church group retreats. The children's' camp that is sponsored by our own Troup Baptist Association is the largest camp of the summer season with over 200 children in attendance.

The purpose of Camp Rockridge is to provide a place where one can come away from the rush and distractions of the world and spend some time with the Creator in His beautiful creation. Testimonies abound of how people of all ages have come to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior as a result of attending a camp at Rockridge. Similar testimonies

abound of how people have grown closer to the Lord as a result of attending a retreat at the camp. I can speak personally as to how just turning into the drive at the camp always brings to me a palpable sense of peace. The further I go onto the property, the more the cares of this world just seem to fall away. Rockridge truly is a special place.

A number of renovations have already taken place at the camp over these past two years and many more are planned. The Camp Director (Rhodes Skinner), the Board of Trustees, and numerous Christian leaders all desire to see the camp continue to receive much-needed updates and additions in order to better serve all people who visit Rockridge. I know I don't do this often, but I ask you to pray about how you could possibly help the camp as a volunteer, financially, and/or as a prayer partner. I am in the process of coordinating an outing for us as a church to go up to Rockridge one Sunday after large-group worship and have a time of fellowship. I'll keep you posted as details are worked out. I would love for us all to go and experience the beauty and peace of our camp!
